
- 1. Currently Chairman of Shin Kong Life from June 2023 and Chairman of Shin Kong Financial Holding from July 2024.




Taiwan Stock Exchange Weighted Index in The Last Decade


Foreign Investor Taiwan Stock Trading Volume (Total Amount)

- The trading volume of foreign investors accounted for averagely 30% of the Stock Exchange Market.



Taiwan GDP Growth Rate





Total Assets of Taiwan Financial Industry by Sectors







Taiwan Pension Fund Scale




Taiwan Pension Onshore/Offshore Asset Allocation

Total Assets of Taiwan Insurance Industry Last Decade




• Among the total assets of US\$1,106 billion, life insurance accounted for 98.7%, while 1.3% for non-life insurance.
